Handling Lost, Stolen and Misused Meal Tickets**

The district will make certain that students receive the meals they pay for or are entitled to. It is recognized that meal tickets are sometimes lost by a student. When a lunch ticket is missing, the district shall reissue a ticket. Each student is allowed, when necessary, to be issued three meal ticket replacements within a school year. A list recording replacement tickets shall be maintained at the school office. After three ticket replacements in a school year a student shall be denied another replacement ticket.

Students shall be notified in writing after the second replacement ticket that after a third loss, he/she will be expected to bring a lunch or pay the full lunch price.

Disabled and young students (through grade 2) who may be unable to take full responsibility for a meal ticket shall be exempt. These students must always receive a meal.

Parents will be provided a notice of this policy at the time applications are distributed to households. Students shall be notified of this policy each fall in a student handbook.

Any student found to have misused his/her meal ticket (i.e., selling or giving ticket to another) will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.
