

Instructional Resources/Instructional Materials

The Board is responsible for the selection of instructional materials. Materials selected shall be aligned with the curriculum as described in Board policy IF - Curriculum Development and Review. The Board delegates to district professional personnel the authority for the selection of instructional and library materials.

Selection Objectives

Textbooks and other instructional materials adopted by the Board shall be selected by the appropriate professional personnel in consultation with parents and citizens. The input of staff and students will be encouraged. Final decisions on purchase will rest with the superintendent or designee, subject to official adoption by the Board in the case of textbooks and other instructional materials.

Selection Criteria

To be in compliance with the requirements of federal law, the Board directs the superintendent or designee to distribute curriculum materials and instructional supplies to district schools in such a manner that ensures all schools receive equivalent materials.

Any resident or employee may challenge the appropriateness of the district's instructional materials. The district will provide a procedure to process such challenges.
